

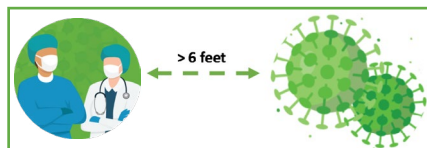
# Crisis Prioritization for Optimizing the Supply of Facemasks and Respirators during COVID-19

Adapted from the CDC guidance on facemask/respirator use amongst healthcare providers. Organizations may require and/or individuals may voluntarily choose to utilize higher levels of protection.



I am a healthcare provider in a facility with symptomatic COVID-19 patients and I will...

Remain more than 6 feet from a symptomatic patient



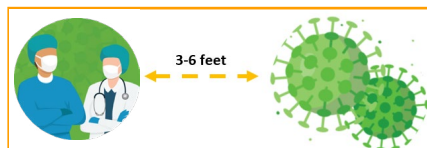
No entry to patient care area is needed **AND** patient masked throughout

No facemask/respirator needed **AND** perform hand hygiene

Entry into the patient care area becomes necessary **OR** patient is unmasked at any point during encounter

Facemask can be used **AND** perform hand hygiene

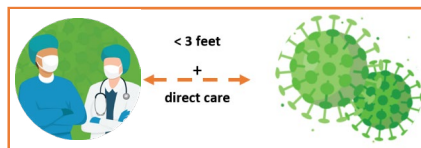
Be within 3-6 feet of a symptomatic patient



Patient masked **OR** unmasked

Facemask, eye protection **AND** perform hand hygiene

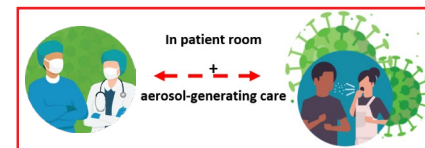
Be within 3-6 feet of a symptomatic patient AND provide direct care



Patient masked **OR** unmasked

Facemask OR N95/ elastomeric respirator + Eye protection **OR** PAPR **AND** perform hand hygiene

Be in the room during aerosol-generating procedures



N95/elastomeric respirator + eye protection **OR** PAPR **AND** perform hand hygiene
